

*WHATSOEVER
YE SHALL ASK*

“...whatsoever ye shall ask
of the Father in my name,
he may give it you.”

Gospel of JOHN chapter 15 verse 16

Our Lord said “*..whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you*” What is our Lord Jesus Christ talking about?—“*Whatsoever ye shall ask...*”

Do you know what His name means? JESUS means ‘*GOD is salvation*’; this is what the angel of the Lord declared to Joseph “*thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he SHALL save his people from their sins.*” (MATTHEW 1:21)

All His beloved people will be made to pray, as Peter prayed “*Lord, save me!*” (MATTHEW 14:30) as the Canaanite woman prayed “*Lord, help me!*” (MATTHEW 15:22-28) as his disciples prayed “*Lord, save us: we perish!*” (MATTHEW 8:25)

Oh! that the LORD give someone reading this leaflet the ability to see the glory and perfection of the LORD JESUS CHRIST, and their need of it! Dear reader, have you seen the glory and perfection of the only man acceptable in His sight, and made you to pray in the name of that man, as only His people can by God’s sovereign grace — “*Lord, save me!*”, “*Lord, help me!*”, “*Lord, save me: else I perish!*”
